

Chess challenge

YOUNG chess enthusiasts in north east Fife are being invited to take part in the Fife schools chess team challenge.

The tournament will take place at Glenwood High School in Glenrothes on Saturday, June 17.

Teams are made up of four players who attend the same school, and there are separate competitions for both primary and secondary teams.

The easiest way for teams to enter is through their school chess club.

However, where there is no school club or where the school club itself can't manage to enter a team, pupils from the same school are welcome to form a team to represent their school and contact the tournament organisers.
